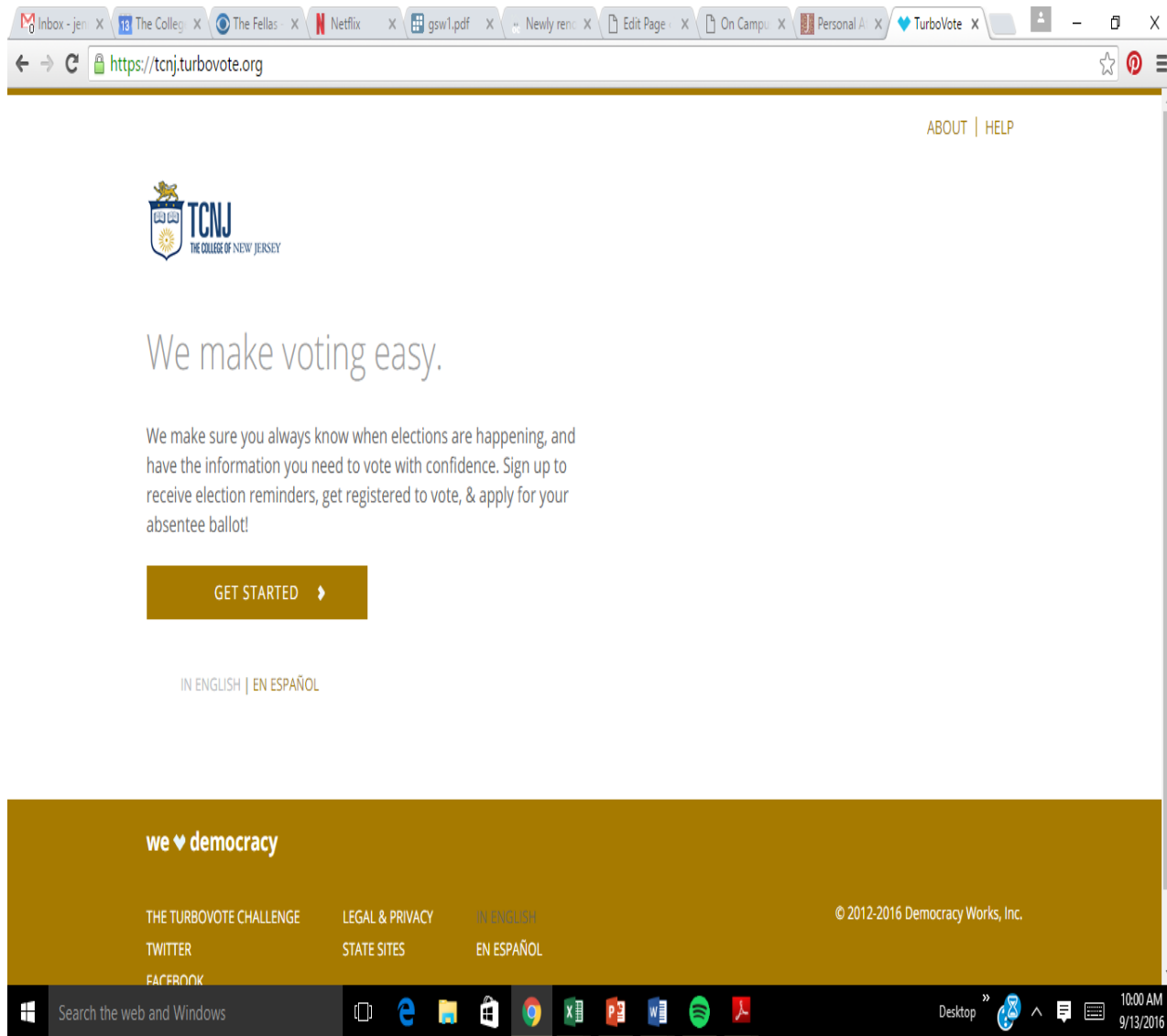


Turbo Vote Walk Through

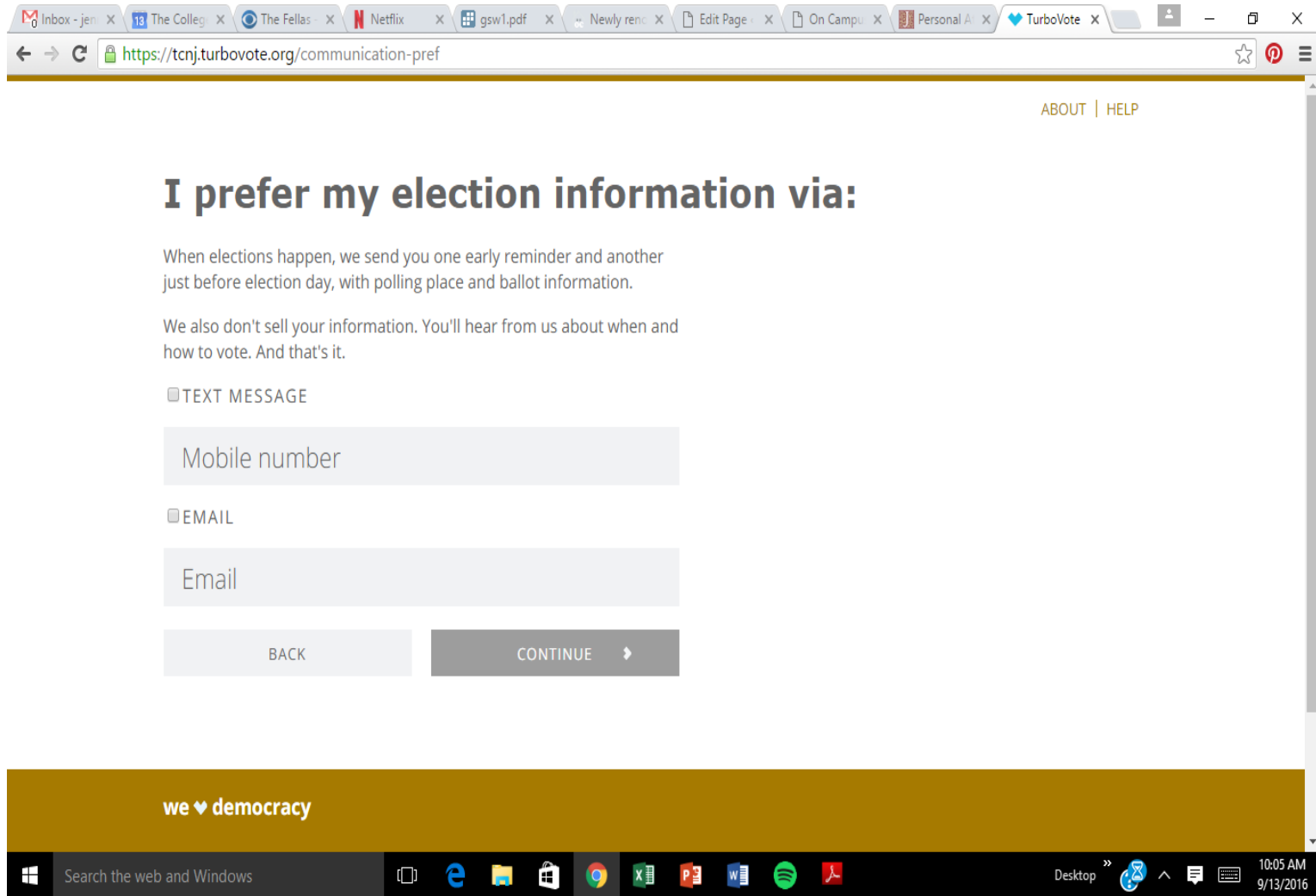

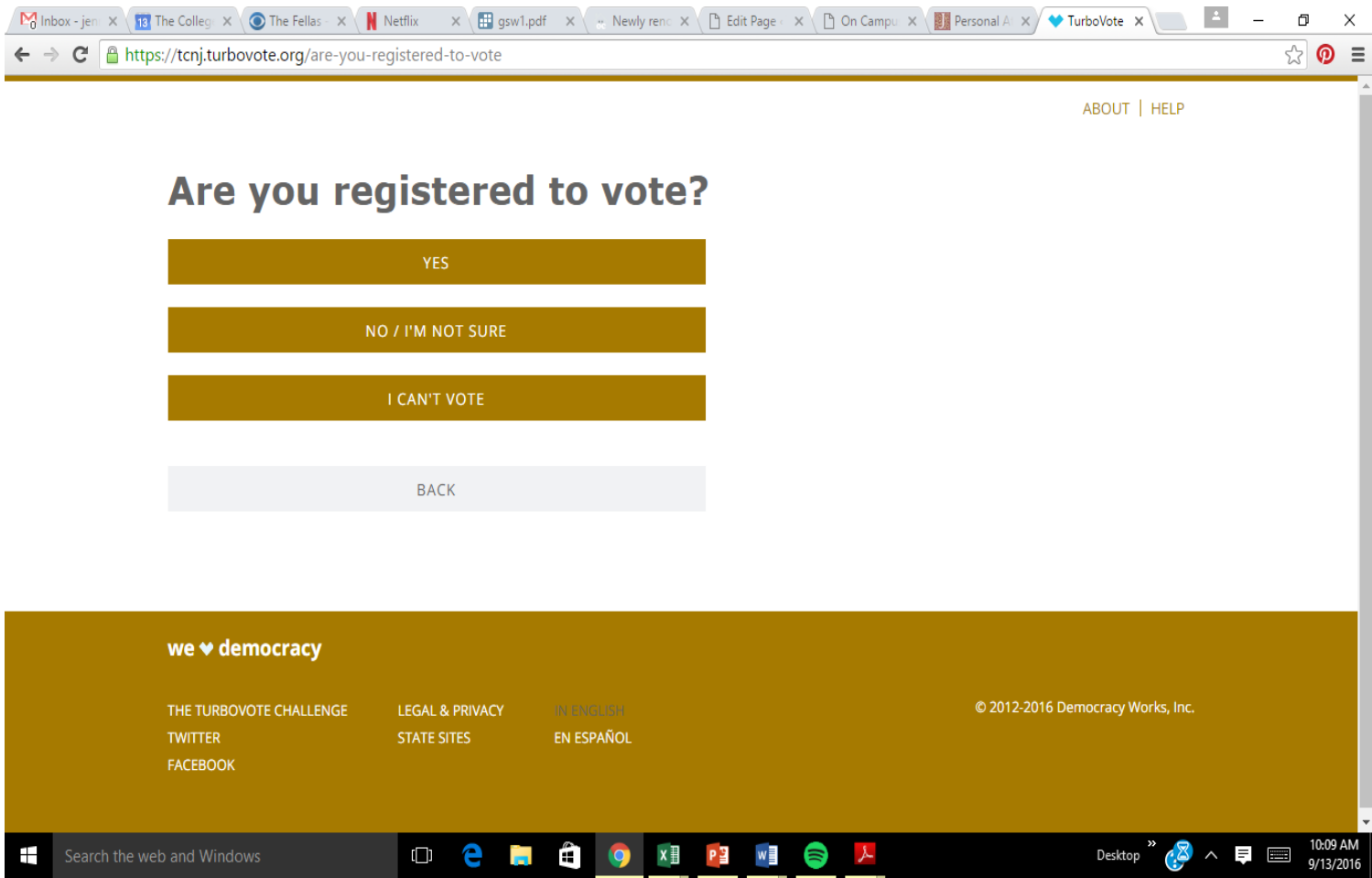

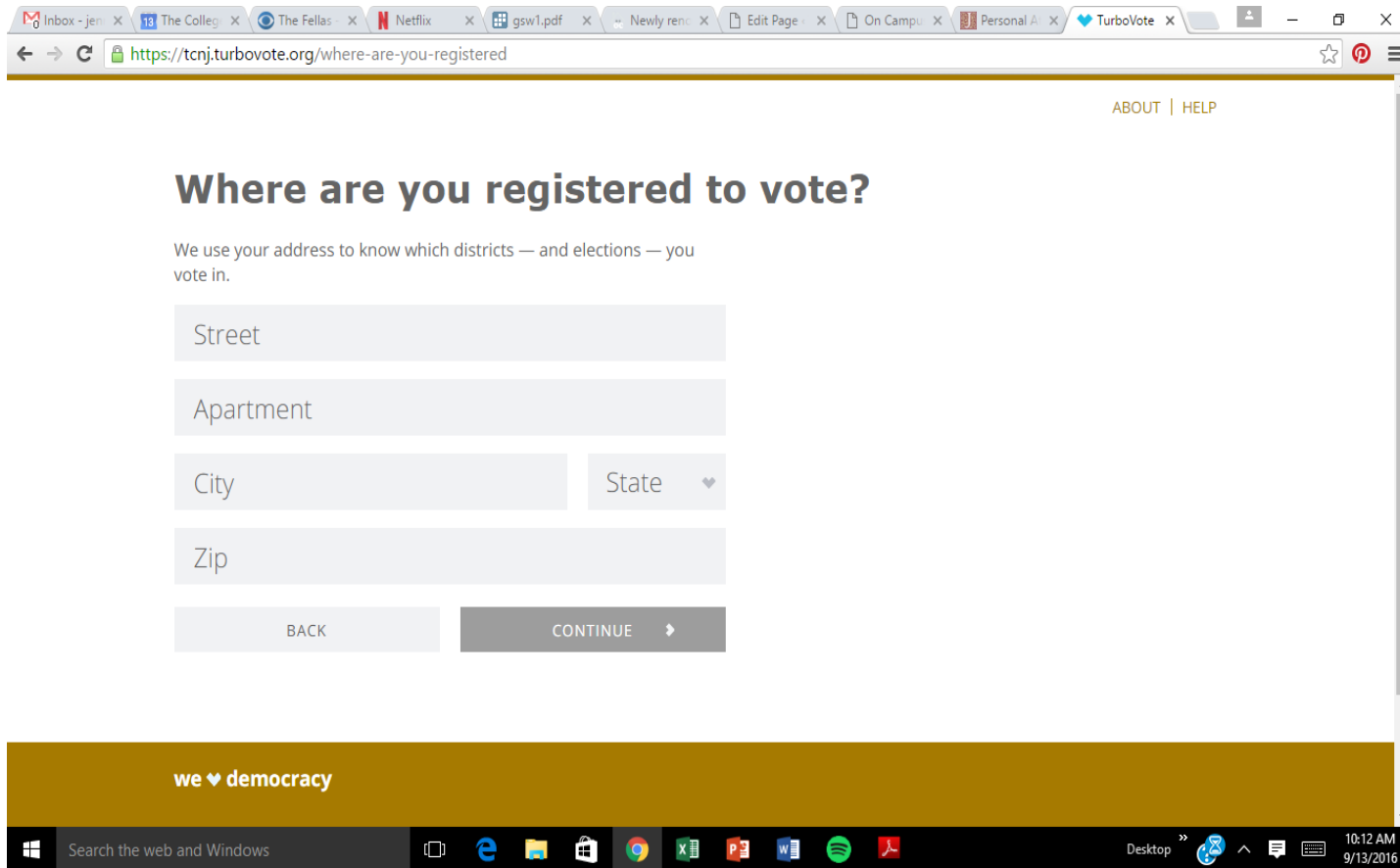
The next page you will see will tell you to put the name on your ID. You may choose to put a nickname if you would like under you should call me.



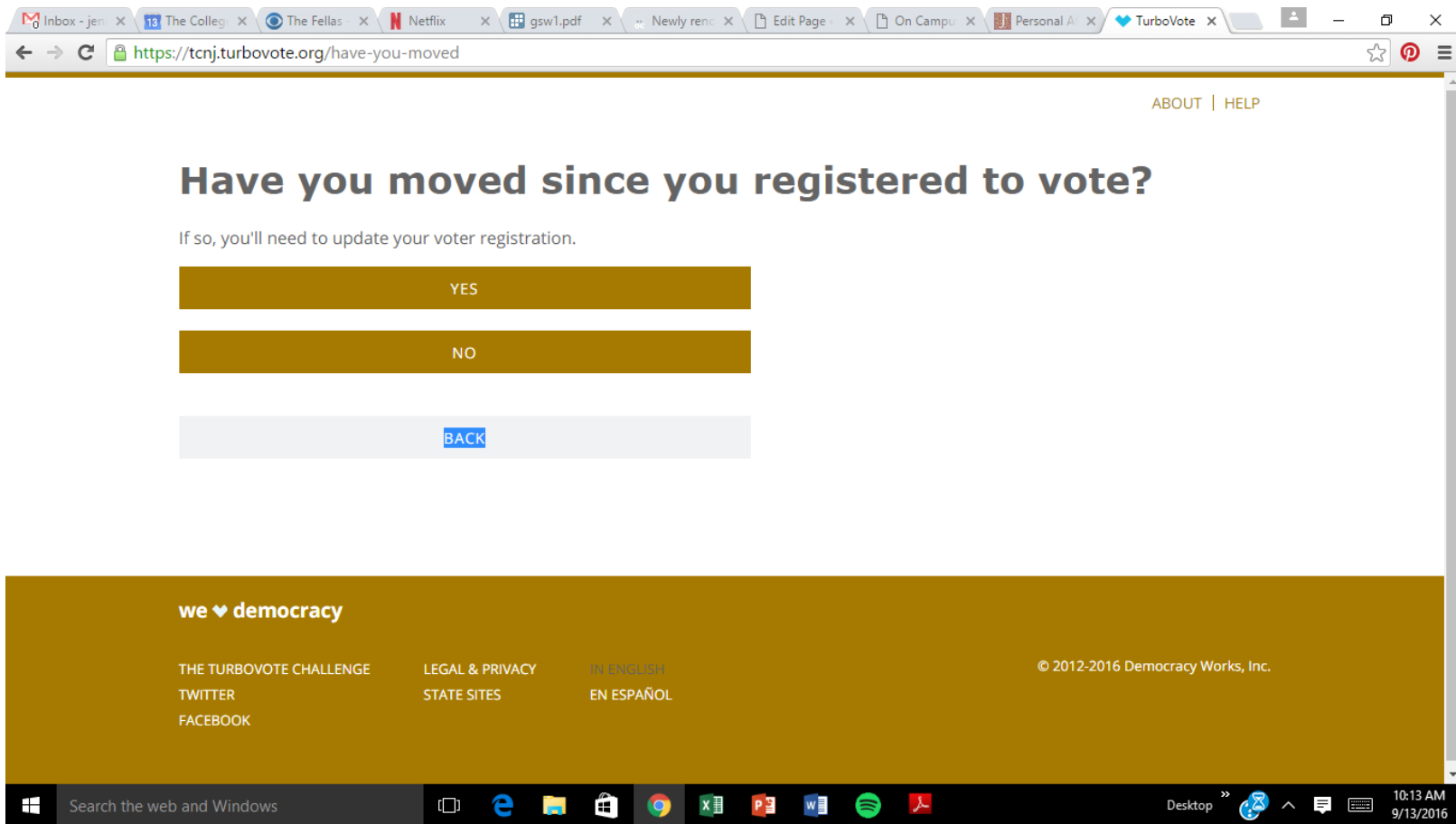
On this page, you will choose whether to receive reminders via text message or email. You may choose to have them get send either way. Reminders will be sent out before election day to remind you to vote or to request a mail-in-ballot.



This screen asks if you are registered to vote or if you are going to register now. You can pick which option applies to you and fill out the information that follows.



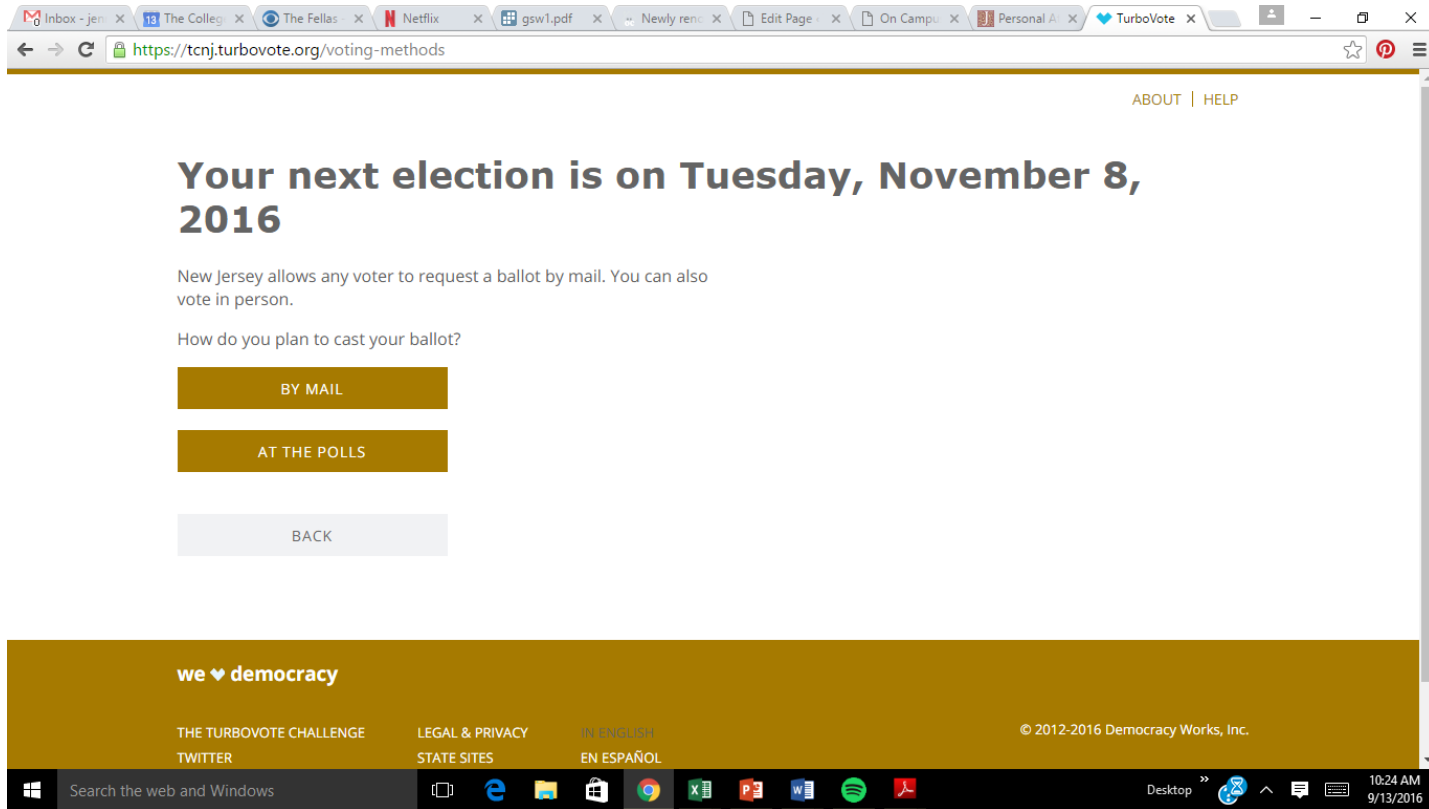
If you choose that you are already registered to vote, you will fill out the information stating where you are registered to vote. If you choose that you are not registered to vote, you will fill out the same information on a different page.



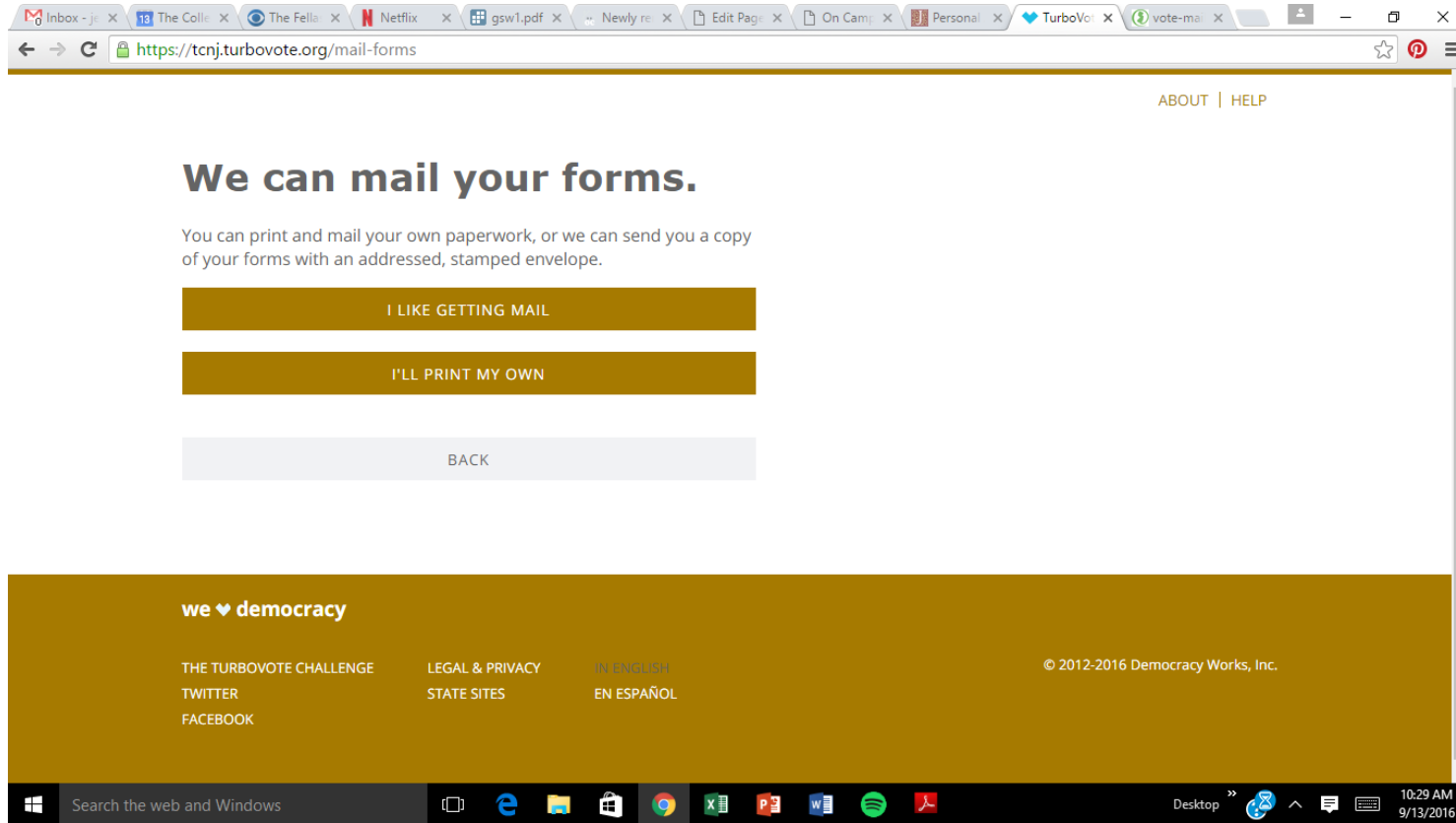
On the next slide, it asks you if you have moved since you last registered to vote. If you have not, just press no and continue. If you have, it will ask you to write in your new address.

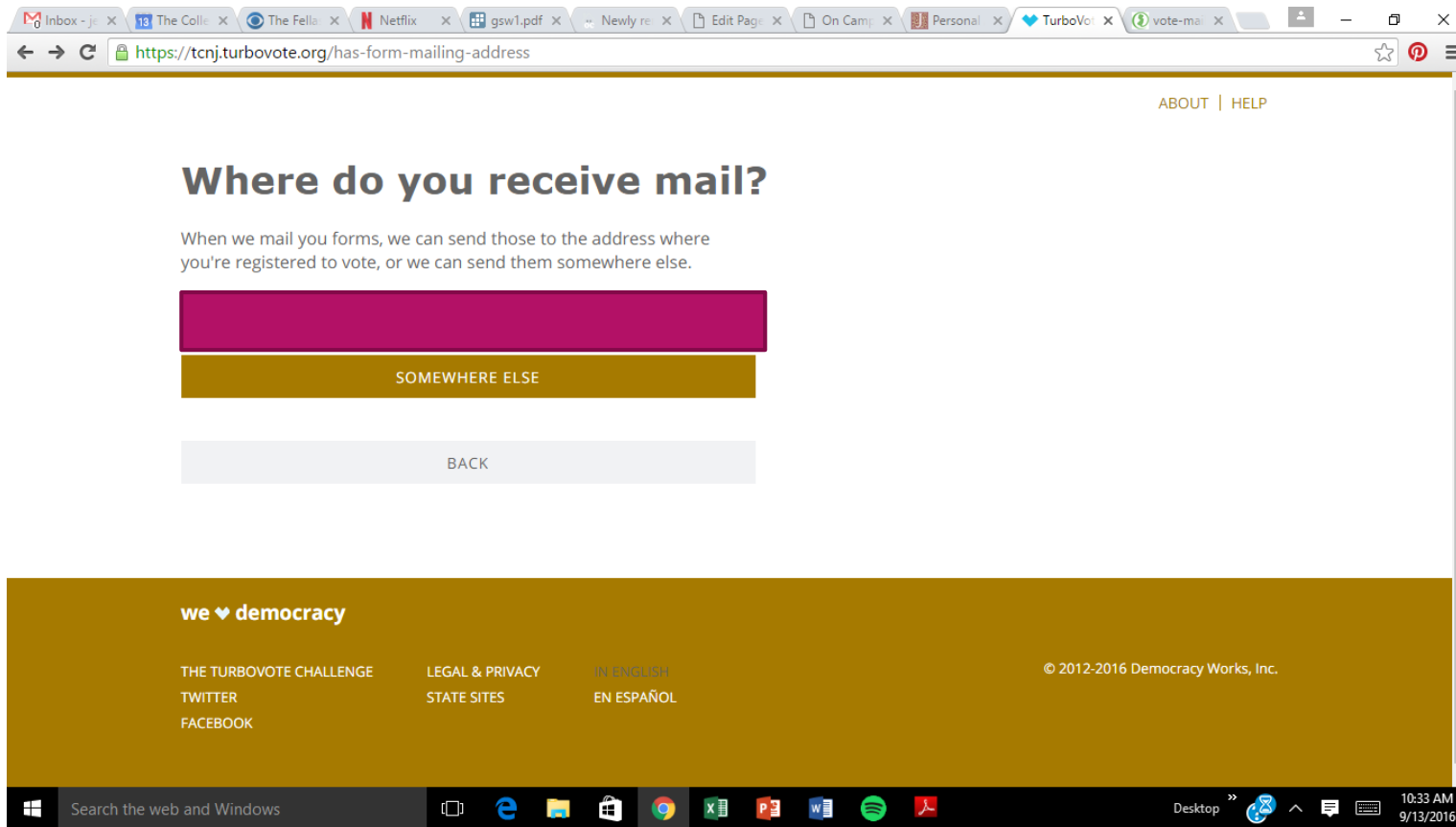
Next, you will have the option of choosing to affiliate with a party. You can choose a party or choose to affiliate with none.



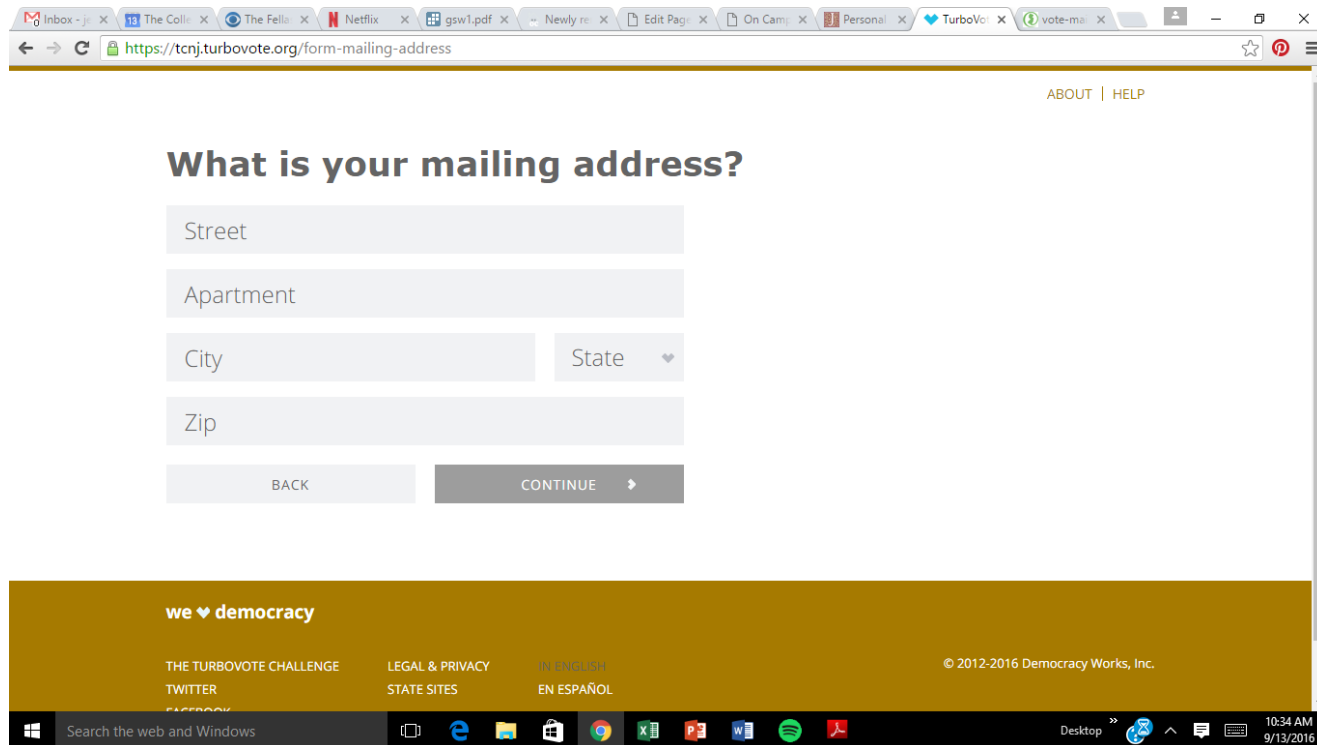
This slide asks how you plan to vote for the next election. You are able to choose to vote in person or by mail. The reminders that you will receive will partially be decided by this factor. If you choose to vote in person, election day, you will go to your registered polling place and vote. If you choose to vote by mail, you will get a reminder of when you have to request the ballot and when you have to mail it.



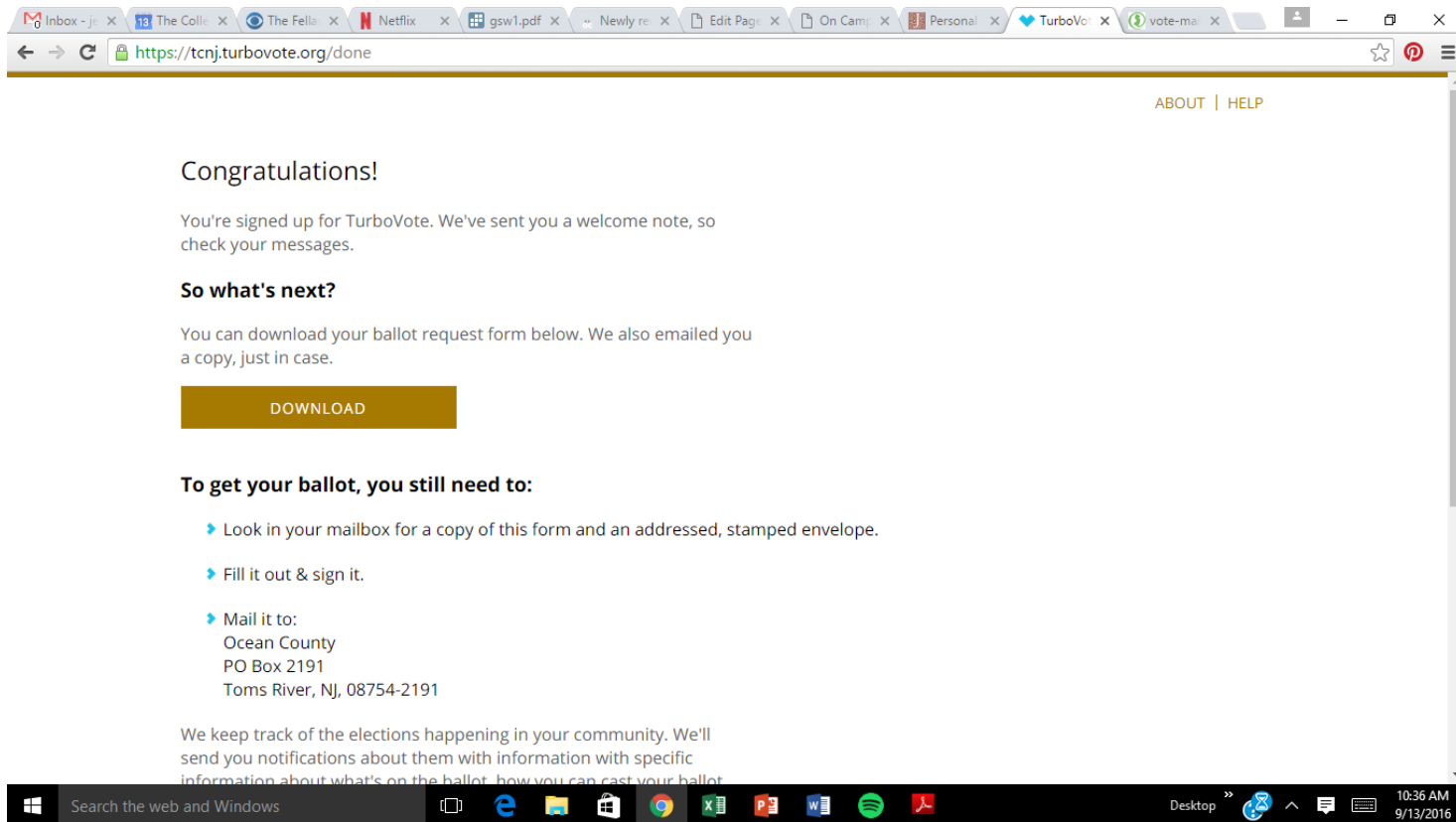
On this slide, you can choose to either print out any forms and mail them yourself, or have TurboVote mail you the papers with a stamped envelope and you can then fill out the information and put it in the stamped envelope and send it.



On this screen you can choose whether you receive mail at your home address or some place else.



On this screen, you can fill out your mailing address. If you choose that your home address and mailing address are the same, you will not have to fill out this page. If you live on campus, do not forget to put the building and room number you live in.



This final page will tell you either where you need to send your registration form, your mail in ballot request, or what your next steps are. Turbo Vote will send reminders after this step to either your phone or email.

Final Reminders

- ▶ If you live on campus and choose to register on campus, do not forget to put your dorm room information to ensure you receive your mail.
- ▶ If you are registering in Ewing, the polling location is at the church across the street from campus which will allow for easy access to the polls.
- ▶ Important Dates: Registration Deadline: October 18
Mail-in-ballot request form deadline: November 1
Election Day: November 8
